In a property damage case involving more than 300 dead calves, Mr. Frankenger represented an agricultural feed manufacturer and achieved a jury verdict of \$73,000 after a demand of \$800,000. In a premises liability case involving a swim club and school district, Mr. Frankenger achieved a double defense verdict after a jury demand of more than \$700,000. In a commercial trucking/personal injury/TBI case, Mr. Frankenger represented a trucking company and one of its employees. Before trial, plaintiffs demanded \$8.8 million. After two weeks in trial, the case settled for \$1.3 million. Mr. Frankenger has tried more than 20 cases through to jury verdict. He was selected as an American Board of Trial Advocates (ABOTA) Associate. Best Lawyers recognized him as a Best Lawyer in 2018-2023. Martindale-Hubbell rated him AV[®]-Preeminent.
